## (U//LES) Anarchist Advocates Adopting the St. Paul Principles for Occupy Chicago

(U//LES) An individual involved in anarchist activity in Chicago, Illinois, has advocated enacting the St. Paul Principles as a guide for the conduct of Occupy Chicago participants.

- (U) The St. Paul Principles were adopted by individuals who were opposed to, and attempted to use violence to disrupt the 2008 Republican National Convention (RNC) held in Minneapolis St. Paul, Minnesota.
- (U) The initial groups agreeing on the St. Paul Principles were the RNC Welcoming Committee, the Coalition to March on the RNC and Stop the War, the Anti-War Committee, Students for a Democratic Society University of Minnesota, Communities United Against Police Brutality, the Welfare Rights Committee and Unconventional Action Chicago.
- (U) The St Paul Principles are:
- (U) Law Enforcement Sensitive: This information is the property of the FBI and may be distributed to state, tribal, or local government law enforcement officials with a need-to-know.
